Author's Comments

Americans thrive on competition; it's innate in our character. Every summer in Spivey's Corner, No. Carolina, they hold the national Hollerin' Contest. On independence Day, Coney Island plays host to Nathan's Famous hot dog eating challenge. Lawn Mower Racing is an established sport in the south and the annual Redneck Games in Georgia feature hubcap hurling, toilet seat tosses and mud pit belly flopping.

In the mid-1990s, documentarian S.R. Butler captured the Hands on a Hardbody competition in Longview Texas. Amanda Green, Trey Anastasio and I felt the film was ripe for theatrical adaptation. We believe it's more relevant today

than it was upon its release; our recent

economic tumult has brought age-old fissures of race, class and income inequality to the foreground. The truck brings the disparate individuals together, who otherwise would never meet, to confront these issues with a startling directness. Implicit in the contest in the American myth of mobility, embodied by an automobile. The truck offers plenty of metaphors; for one contestant, it's a new lease on life, for another, it is his manhood, for a third, it's about her religious faith.

The show is a chance to explore my roots in a state that's simultaneously maddening and exhilarating, punchdrunk on its own rich mythology, tounge-in-cheek braggadocio, abundant good humor and a boundless sky. For Amanda and Trey, it's an opportunity to forge a score inspired by doggedly individualistic, real-life people.

On the one hand, anyone with the skill and perseverance can triumph, but beneath that bright promise lies a darker truth. Darwin's cruel truth about the survival of the fittest. — Doug Wright

Director's Notes

I have totally fallen in love with the music in this show, but it is not your typical musical show. This is the story of real live people, who were down on their luck and very determined to win. They put all of their hopes and dreams, their desires and needs into winning that truck, but nothing is that simple. Only one person can win and drive home in a new truck though, as the minutes and hours drag on into days, they become less self-centered. They let their guard down and became vulnerable and, in the process, began to realize that they were not so different from anyone else around the truck. During the course of the contest, almost 5 days, they slowly developed a camaraderie, yet they all know that they may compete against each other again next year. Just because the truck is gone, the contest of life goes on and on!

Larry Spinner (Director) - Larry has a rather eclectic background. He began acting and working on tech crews in high school and community theater, before earning a B.S. in Pharmacy. After a back injury, he went back to school, where he discovered directing, and earned an M.A. in Theater. Soon after that, he fell backwards into teaching and began a 14-year gig acting like a high school science and drama teacher. Along the way he also accumulated a long list of theater credits, as a director, actor and stage manager. Since moving to Summerville 4 years ago, he has become an active member of the Flowertown Players and is often found at one production or another. He was last seen on stage in the Flowertown Underground's production of 12 Angry Men in September 2019 and he will be directing again with next season's Christmas comedy, A Doublewide, Texas Christmas.
